

A serious disruption of the functioning of a community or society, which involve widespread human, material, economic or environmental impacts that exceed the ability of the affected community or society to cope using its own resources. Disaster management is how we deal with the human, material, economic or environmental impacts of said disaster, it is the process of how we "prepare for, respond to and learn from the effects of major failures"

The combination of hazards, vulnerability and inability to reduce the potential negative consequences of risk results in disaster (Vulnerability+ Hazard) / Capacity = Disaster

Emergency management (also disaster management) is a science and a system charged with creating the framework within which communities reduce vulnerability to hazards and cope with disasters. Emergency managers think of disasters as recurring events with four phases: Mitigation, Preparedness, Response, and Recovery.

Impacts. A natural disaster may cause loss of life, injury or other health impacts, property damage, loss of livelihoods and services, social and economic disruption, or environmental damage.

Our Chairman and Founder emphasizes on 4Ps of emergency response: Predict, Plan, Prepare, and Practice are committed to fostering the four Cs: communication, coordination, collaboration, and cooperation.





AGENCIES INVOLVEMENT

Since 1982

The Disaster Management Act of 2005 defines Disaster Management as an integrated process of planning, organizing, coordinating and implementing measures which are necessary for-

- Prevention of threat of any disaster
- Reduction of risk of any disaster or its consequences
- Readiness to deal with any disaster
- Promptness in dealing with a disaster
- Assessing the severity of the effects of any disaster
- Rescue and relief
- Rehabilitation and Reconstruction




Agencies involved in Disaster Management

- **National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA):-** NDMA, is an apex body for disaster management, headed by the Prime Minister of India. It is responsible for the supervision, direction, and control of the National Disaster Response Force (NDRF).
- National Executive Committee (NEC):- The NEC is composed of high profile ministerial members from the government of India that include the Union Home Secretary as Chairperson, and the Secretaries to the Government of India (GoI) like Ministries / Departments of Agriculture, Atomic Energy, Defence, Drinking Water Supply, Environment and Forests, etc. The NEC prepares the National Plan for Disaster Management as per the National Policy on Disaster Management.
- State Disaster Management Authority (SDMA):- The Chief Minister of the respective state is the head of the SDMA. The State Government has a State Executive Committee (SEC) which assists the State Disaster Management Authority (SDMA) on Disaster Management.
- District Disaster Management Authority (DDMA):- The DDMA is headed by the District Collector, Deputy Commissioner or District Magistrate depending on the situation, with the elected representatives of the local authority as the Co-Chairperson. The DDMA ensures that the guidelines framed by the NDMA and the SDMA are followed by all the departments of the State Government at the District level and the local authorities in the District.
- Local Authorities:- Local authorities include Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRI), Municipalities, District and Cantonment 11 Institutional and Legal Arrangements Boards, and Town Planning Authorities which control and manage civic services.

STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES



A Standard Operating Procedure has been prepared for alerts of events of different types and identifies the situations when alerts are to be sent by the IOC. Specific hazards have different categories of alerts. Accordingly, a uniform system has been devised by categorizing each type of alert in stages – Yellow, Orange and Red

SOPs cover the following aspects:

- Official on duty who detects the incident first will inform the control rooms functional round the clock and control room in turn will further inform immediately to NDRF/SDRF, local authorities like local police, fire brigade, hospitals and other local authorities. Simultaneously informing all senior officials who in turn will inform all the concerned Ministries/ Departments for seeking assistance.
- Quickly mobilize the trained security staff and volunteers to handle emergencies once the 'warning or signal' is on.
- Segregating the affected areas to avoid further damage.
- Evacuate employees and officers quickly from the office premises without any delay and in the case of colony from the affected place / premise.
- Loud-Hailer for making announcements.
- Supply of safe drinking water, water quality monitoring and improved sanitation
- Keep first aid kit ready in the welfare cell of the office and in Community Centre of the Colony.
- Ambulance equipped with life supporting system for transportation of injured / casualties.
- Prompt action including assistance from locals to evacuate stranded officials / families in operational area
- Operation and manning of the disaster control room.
- Coordination amongst various stakeholders through advance warnings.
- Communication system with backups

- Identify appropriate locations to set up the emergency operation camps during any disaster event
- Arrange or identify the available sources for standby generators for every contingency
- Vector control measures as a part of the overall community sanitation activities
- Sanitation of sewage and drainage systems for smooth flow of waste/ water
- Developing proper solid waste, E-waste management systems
- Develop systems of awareness generation among most vulnerable communities about various infectious diseases and their Prevention
- Arrangement for vehicles during emergencies for transport of injured persons
- Installation of suitable warning & security system.
- Maintenance of uninterrupted communication
- Create awareness among the staff about Disaster Management Plan (DMP), preparedness, DOs & DONT's during emergencies and relief measures
- Publishing contact addresses and telephone numbers of responsible authorities namely Fire Department, Police, District Collector/ Commissioner, Meteorological Dept, Hospitals etc.
- Conduct periodical inspections or safety audits to check the readiness of EMS Conducting mock exercises to ensure automatic activation of EMS in case of emergency.
- Devise continuity plans ready for quick restoration of normalcy



PREPAREDNESS

- Don't Forget Those With Special Needs (Infants, seniors and those with special needs etc.)
- Learn CPR and First Aid (basic first aid and CPR)
- Eliminate Hazards in Your Home and The Workplace (secure the contents of your home or office to reduce hazards)
- Understand Post-9/11 Risks (Man-made / natural disasters Be
 Informed Explosions, Chemical, Biological, and Nuclear Threats)
- Get Involved, Volunteer, Bear Responsibility (Donate blood, join a Community Emergency Response Team (CERT), educate your neighbor, or volunteer)







TRAINING AND WORKSHOP



In partnership with academic institutions, governments, international organizations and other UN agencies, Eagle Hunter contributes to facilitate the exchange of best practices, experiences and approaches to better manage disasters. First Aid is immediate care of an ill or injured person before professional medical help is available. Skills are needed to take care of the 4As i.e Awareness-Assessment-Action-Aftercare of a victim for immediate assessment to reassure, restore breathing and stop bleeding. **First aid training comprises of** general first aid steps, primary and secondary assessments, CPR and application of any of the other 20 or more first aid procedures/protocols needed to deal with medical emergencies including heart attack, stroke, bleeding, spinal injury, burn, snake bites, jellyfish sting, heat and cold emergencies. Eagle Hunter offers First-aid training programmes for everyone to learn recovery and revival skills so that they can provide assistance and be first responders in case of an emergency.

Training Method – Theory + Practical + Exam, Course Duration – 12-14 Hours, Minimum Age – 15 years

Training comprises of **survival swimming lessons**, endurance swimming, rescue swimming, dry and wet lifesaving in floods, motor boat operation, IRB and OBM maintenance, rescue with rescue boat, snake handling, pathogenic diseases in floods and their precautions, basic search and rescue diving using SCUBA equipment and complete first aid for emergency response. It has been specially designed for professional flood and disaster management e.g for national, states and districts disaster management organisations The Ac Disaster Response Team Management & Rescue Diving Training is conducted in six phases.

Training Method – Theory + Practical +Exam, Course Duration – 28 days, Minimum Age – 18 years

A **Lifesaver** is trained to rescue a drowning person while keeping himself/herself safe and is capable of giving CPR and first aid. In Pool Lifesaver training one learns safe entry into swimming pool, safe approach and safe rescue of a drowning victim. The training includes underwater search, methods of rescue, use of rescue equipment, escaping hold of a drowning person and complete first aid. Our aim is to have 'One lifesaver in every family', thus making our water bodies safe.

Training Method – Theory + Practical + Exam, Course Duration – 30 Hours, Minimum Age – 14 years, Prerequisites – 300 mtr swim in 12 min , 25 mtr underwater swim; can stand with hands up in deep water for 1 min – (eggbeater kick)

TRAINING AND WORKSHOP - MODULES



Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) is the single most useful resuscitation method for an unconscious victim. When a person's breathing has stopped, a First-aider has only 3-4 minutes to revive the victim as thereafter the brain cells would start to die, resulting in permanent damage and even death. To restore breathing before any medical help is available start CPR.

Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) comprises of: Expired Air Resuscitation (EAR) + External Chest Compression = CPR Training Method – Theory + Practical + Exam, Course Duration – 3 Hours, Minimum Age – 10 years

Trauma is caused by an accident resulting in injury or wounds. Immediate assessment, providing necessary first aid before professional help arrives and handling critically injured person with knowledgeable care is called Trauma Management. Trauma Management training comprises of CPR and care of 6 -8 critical emergencies of accident victims.

Although we recommend every person to undergo a complete first-aid course comprising CPR and 20+ emergencies which will stand him/her in good stead at home, in transit or at work place, Eagle Hunter Disaster Management Services offers Trauma Management training for everyone who wishes to learn recovery and revival skills so that they can help and provide care as a first responder at an accident site. Training Method – Theory + Practical + Exam, Course Duration – 6-7 Hours, Minimum Age – 15 years

Save a Baby training consists of general first aid steps, CPR and de-choking of an infant or child and managing other medical emergencies in children like febrile fever, seizure, croup and SIDS or sudden infant death syndrome. Of the preventive measures, keep poisons, electrical and sharp objects out of reach of baby or child.

Training Method – Theory + Practical + Exam, Course Duration – 6 Hours, Minimum Age – 16 years

In case of Cardiac Arrest, abnormal or no rhythm of heart muscles can cause the heart to stop pumping blood. Although with CPR we can maintain circulation, sometimes the heart may not start beating. **Automatic External Defibrillator (AED)** machine analyses the victim's heart rhythm and tells you how to give electric shock(s) if needed. It also guides with voice command on how to do **CPR** (for untrained persons). Thus AED helps restarting normal rhythms of the heart. During CPR, use of an oxygen kit also improves the result by providing higher percentage of oxygen to the brain, and therefore results in quicker recovery.

Training Method – Theory + Practical + Exam, Course Duration – 4 Hours, Minimum Age – 16 years

A **Lifeguard** is a person responsible to maintain safety and prevent accidents in water bodies under his/ her care. In Open Water & Beach Lifeguard training one learns how to maintain safety at ponds, lakes, rivers & beaches, take measures to prevent accidents, enforce safety rules and display flags at a beach, beach patrolling, scanning, advanced aquatic rescue skills, use of rescue equipment, rescue with motor boat/ jet ski, rescue with rescue board, beach survey for safety assessment, and complete first aid.

Training Method – Theory + Practical + Exam, Course Duration – 42 Hours, Minimum Age – 16 years and Prerequisites – 500 meters swim in 15 min , 30 meters underwater swim, can stand with hands up un deep water for 3 mins – (eggbeater kick)
